- Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces

We are fortunate to have a government that understands how essential construction is, but we can't take that for granted! We must all have plans in place and be responsible for ensuring we are following them strictly to avoid undue scrutiny and potential forced shutdown of our sites.

Here's what SOS is doing to help

- We have educated ourselves about this outbreak and continue to do so daily.
- We are working with our clients to ensure good, sound, and executable policies are in place to manage the health and safety of their employees and minimize the impact on their business.
- We have increased our spending in support of local businesses that are impacted and where possible focused our money locally. We are sourcing American made products to keep needed funds in our country.
- We are giving to local non-profits to support in any way we can and encourage other businesses to do the same.
- We have spent a substantial amount of time and money expanding our business to support our new SOS PROS - DECON TEAM and service.

While some may be inclined to hunker down and wait out the storm. We are adding folks to our team (some of which have lost other work due to the virus), training them, and putting them to work on the front lines.

We have assembled a team of bright, healthy, and well-trained individuals to support our newest SOS PROS – DECON SERVICE. This is a support service aimed at helping construction companies and sites disinfect commonly touched surfaces, spaces, tools, offices, vehicles, and equipment. In addition to helping construction sites and projects develop Covid-19 protocols, we are actively deploying highly trained mobile teams with state-of-the-art ULV Microparticle disinfecting apparatus including positively charged vapor dispersion units to act on government mandates to disinfect frequently used items and surfaces. We have worked tirelessly to secure a reliable supply of EPA (N) listed products shown to be effective at killing the Covid-19 Virus! This was no small task with the current shortage of all disinfectant products. We have secured several product types that are effective for outdoor and indoor settings including some that are used in the foodservice and airline industry. As is consistent with our primary health and safety mission all of our team members have received training in the proper storage, care, and use of these products. We have sourced products that are safe for your employees after they have been applied. Your employees can be back in the space or in contact with the treated surface within (30) minutes in most cases.





How our SOS PROS – DECON SERVICE WORKS

In most cases, this service is being elected as a precautionary measure to help prevent the spread of the virus and meet disinfecting requirements issued by the national and local government.

However, in some instances, the virus has been identified on the site and a self-quarantine of the facility or site has been imposed. In this case, multiple applications would be needed to ensure all potentially infected surfaces have been repeatedly treated and the potential for recontamination from the source is minimized prior to reopening. In all cases we will conduct a fact-finding questionnaire to ensure we are fully aware of all site hazards, potential exposure, and what other precautions are being followed as part of the overall mitigation plan of the site. After an evaluation of your facility, project, and a clear understanding of your needs we will discuss the best service solution for your particular situation.

To conduct the services a small mobile crew will be deployed to your site. EPA (N) listed disinfectants will be deployed using state-of-the-art ULV Microparticle disinfecting apparatus or positively charged vapor dispersion units as may be appropriate for your given facility. While the products we use pose little risk, our team members will be fully dressed out in decontamination gear as an added precaution, so they are protected from the virus while they perform the service. While the process poses no serious health risk your staff, team members would need to vacate the space to ensure full access to all surfaces and allow for proper emersion times.

Our charged particle applicators will coat all surfaces in a positively charged virus distroying fog that clings to surfaces with a force many times greater than gravity as our team works from the furthest location of your facility toward the exit. We work ourselves out of the structure to ensure that recontamination is minimized and when we are done your facility is the cleanest possible.

All services will be confirmed with a validation of treatment document to demonstrate to your team, regulatory authorities, and your community that you take the health, and safety of your employees and customers seriously and are doing everything in your power to prevent the spread of disease.

Additional services such as development of an infectious disease control policies and health, safety training will still be offered through our SOS PROS HEALTH AND SAFETY CONSULTING SERVICE.

Please note that aside from any essential medical service provider or public services agency which may require our support during this time of need our SOS PROS – DECON SERVICE is exclusively being offered to those in our industry in our local community.

SOS will be maintaining all normal operations during this time and I will be overseeing those services as normal, but just as the leader of our country is working around the clock myself and my leadership team will be as well. We will be managing our crew's daytime and after-hours operations with boots on the ground. We will not stay at home and hide while there is something we can do to help out.
